**39. SINGLE SOURCE SOLUTIONS**

This section contains terms and conditions governing the provision of Single Source Solutions services to Resellers who shall also meet the general terms and conditions specified throughout this Schedule and as set forth in the [Sprint Resale Terms and Conditions](#). If a Reseller does not meet the terms and conditions specified throughout this schedule, Sprint will notify the Reseller that it is not in compliance with the terms and conditions of its service. The Reseller will have seven days in which to correct any discrepancies. If, after seven days, unless a shorter period of time is otherwise provided in Sprint's Schedules, the Reseller has not complied with the specified terms and conditions in this Schedule, the Reseller's Single Source Solutions service will be terminated and the Reseller will be transferred to a non-Single Source Solutions service.

Sprint Wholesale Outbound Extension is a Sprint Wholesale Dedicated Outbound service subscribed to, and paid for, by the subscriber but which is connected to a subscriber's non-associated locations.

Sprint Wholesale Dedicated Toll Free is an inward-calling service which allows calls from normal shared-use facilities in selected service areas to be terminated via dedicated access lines at the subscriber's location without charge to the caller. Sprint Wholesale Dedicated Toll Free is provided via dedicated access lines, as opposed to local exchange lines. Charges to the subscriber are LATA and time sensitive.

Sprint Wholesale Switched Toll Free service is an inward calling service which allows calls from normal shared-used facilities in selected service areas to be terminated via local exchange lines at the subscriber's location without charge to the caller. Sprint Wholesale Switched Toll Free uses standard telephone lines, so no special lines or equipment are required by the subscriber. Sprint Wholesale Switched Toll Free utilizes Sprint's 100 percent digital, fiber optic network, as do all other Single Source Solutions products. It has a monthly service charge, plus usage charges. Charges to the Sprint Wholesale Switched Toll Free subscriber are LATA and time sensitive.

Sprint Wholesale Toll Free Extension is Sprint Wholesale Dedicated Toll Free service subscribed to, and paid for, by the subscriber, but which is connected to the subscriber's non-associated locations.

Sprint Wholesale Switched Data Services is a flat rated product with a single rate for each jurisdiction and service. Single rates are provided separately for switched and dedicated access and are not band, distance, time-of-day, day-of-week or usage sensitive. Only associated customer locations, as defined in [Definitions for Business Communications Services](#), are allowed to participate in the Sprint Wholesale Switched Data Services offerings. Interstate and international Dial "1" outbound, FONCARD, switched data, interstate toll free inbound, and international toll-free service are available.

Sprint Wholesale Switched Data Services is a flat rated product with a single rate for each jurisdiction and service. Single rates are provided separately for switched and dedicated access and are not band, distance, time-of-day, day-of-week or usage sensitive.

Sprint Wholesale Dedicated Outbound and Sprint Wholesale Outbound Extension services are available from all equal access areas served by the Sprint network in the contiguous United States, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands. Sprint Wholesale Switched Outbound service is available from all Equal Access Areas served by the Sprint Network.

Sprint Wholesale FONCARD Service consists of an authorization code issued by Sprint which the Reseller will incorporate into the Reseller's calling card. The calling card, together with customer-provided enhancements, will be provided in the Reseller's name to the Resale End User who may originate calls over Sprint's network in the contiguous U.S., Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands, Guam, and CNMI, as well as from selected international locations. Sprint will transport customer's calling card traffic with the same quality as Sprint's FONCARD traffic.

5. Resellers

Reseller shall comply with the following requirements in using Sprint's Single Source Solutions service to extend services to its Resale End Users:

- Reseller shall be the service provider with respect to its Resale End Users. Sprint is merely a supplier to Reseller, with no relationship with the Resale End Users. Reseller is solely responsible for Resale End User solicitation, service requests, creditworthiness, customer service, and billing and collection. Reseller will not be relieved of any obligation under this Schedule by virtue of the fact that Sprint's network services are ultimately being used by Resale End Users.
- Reseller shall be financially liable for usage generated by each Resale End User activated by Sprint until such ANI is presubscribed to another IXC. Reseller may request Sprint to block service to a Resale End User upon such end user's failure to pay Reseller, subject to Reseller's prior certification to Sprint that it has given the Resale End User any notice required by law. Reseller shall reimburse Sprint for expenses incurred to block service to a Resale End User.
- Reseller shall be solely liable for amounts it cannot collect from Resale End Users, and billing adjustments it grants to Resale End Users, including adjustments for fraudulent charges, directory assistance or any other form of credit.
- Reseller represents and warrants that 1. it has obtained all licenses and regulatory authority necessary to operate as a telecommunications common carrier and (b) it will not submit a Resale End User ANI for activation without obtaining and maintaining a proper PIC authorization. Reseller shall produce for Sprint's inspection, at Reseller's expense, any PIC authorization within 48 hours after Sprint's oral or written request, or within any shorter period required by a LEC or regulatory agency. If Reseller engages in a pattern of activity suggesting that this section is intentionally being violated, then Sprint may terminate service to Reseller or refuse to activate Resale End User ANIs submitted by Reseller.
- Reseller shall reimburse Sprint for any charge assessed by a LEC for processing a PIC request initiated by Reseller for which Sprint determines lacks a proper PIC Authorization and pay Sprint a PIC Assessment Fee equal to 25% of such charge. Reseller must also reimburse Sprint for any charge imposed by a LEC for complying with Reseller's request to expedite service installation.
- Sprint's provision of Single Source Solutions service to Reseller confers no right to use Sprint's name, service marks, trademarks, copyrights, patents or CIC, except as expressly provided in this schedule. Reseller shall take no action which might compromise Sprint's registered copyrights or service marks. Reseller may not 1. promote or advertise Sprint's name or capabilities to Resale End Users or prospective Resale End Users, (b) attempt to sell its service using Sprint's name, or (c) represent to Resale End Users or prospective Resale End Users that they would be Sprint customers or that they may obtain Sprint service from Reseller.

- Sprint will provide Reseller written notice of a breach of this section. Reseller shall use its best efforts to immediately cure such breach, advising Sprint of its actions. If, in Sprint's opinion, Reseller fails to effect a cure within 30 days of Sprint notice, then Sprint may, at its option, terminate service to Reseller.
- Sprint's provision of Single Source Solutions service may result in Resale End Users being notified by their LEC that Sprint is their designated carrier. Therefore, to avoid confusion and potential "slamming" complaints, Sprint hereby authorizes Reseller to use Sprint's name under the following conditions to provide Resale End Users from whom Reseller has obtained a valid PIC authorization with a fulfillment piece containing the following Notice ("the Notice"):

We want to affirm how (Reseller) will provide your long distance service. Although (Reseller) will provide your invoice and customer service, we use major national carriers to actually carry your long distance calls.

After subscribing to our service, you may receive a notice from your local phone company which says that your long distance "Carrier of Choice" is Sprint. (Reseller) has selected Sprint as the long distance network provider it will use to handle your calls. That selection was based on your quality and price requirements. If you have any questions about your order, please call our toll free customer service number, 1-800-\_\_\_\_-\_\_\_\_.

- If Reseller subscribes to Sprint Wholesale Switched Toll Free service, calls placed by Resale End Users to the Sprint International Toll Free Service number will be answered "Sprint Operator." This may cause confusion if the Resale End User does not know its calls are being carried on the Sprint network. Therefore, to avoid such confusion, Sprint hereby authorizes Reseller to provide Resale End Users with a fulfillment piece containing the following notice (the "Sprint Wholesale Switched Toll Free Notice"): "International call origination may be provided by a Sprint Operator." Sprint may withdraw consent to use the Sprint Wholesale Switched Toll Free Notice upon 10 days written notice to Reseller.
- Reseller must obtain Sprint's prior written approval of any fulfillment piece in which the Notice or the Sprint Wholesale Switched Toll Free Notice will appear.
- Reseller shall indemnify, defend and hold Sprint harmless from and against any and all liabilities, costs, damages, fines, assessments or penalties (including reasonable attorney's fees) resulting from any claim arising out of or relating to: 1. use of Single Source Solutions service by Reseller to extend its service to Resale End Users; (b) use of Single Source Solutions Service by Reseller or Resale End Users; (c) libel, slander, or patent or trademark infringement arising from the combination or use of Single Source Solutions service with Reseller-provided service or facilities; or (d) Reseller's marketing, advertising, sales or promotional activities.

6. Additional Terms and Conditions

The following terms and conditions apply to the provision of Single Source Solutions service to Resellers:

1. Single Source Solutions Non-Bell Service Area Charges

Reseller shall pay a charge for each originating minute and each terminating minute of an interstate call that originates and/or terminates in a Non-Bell Service Area.

2. Single Source Solutions LEC Cap Surcharge

In any month Reseller exceeds the Single Source Solutions Maximum Non-Bell Traffic Percentage specified herein for any service type, Reseller shall pay Sprint the per-minute surcharge specified herein for each minute above the Single Source Solutions' Maximum Non-Bell Traffic Percentage that originates from or terminates to a Non-Bell Service Area. Single Source Solutions Maximum Non-Bell Traffic Percentages will be calculated independently for originating and terminating minutes at each CTIS Product Level Hierarchy.

3. Single Source Solutions Noncomplete Call Surcharge

In any month in which Reseller exceeds the Single Source Solutions Maximum Noncomplete Toll Free Call Percentage for interstate Sprint Wholesale Dedicated Toll Free and/or Sprint Wholesale Switched Toll Free traffic as stated herein, Reseller shall pay Sprint a surcharge equal to the amount stated herein for each Single Source Solutions Noncomplete Toll Free Call in excess of the Single Source Solutions Maximum Noncomplete Toll Free Call Percentage. This surcharge will be calculated at each CTIS Product Hierarchy Level.

4. Single Source Solutions Minimum Port Usage Surcharge

In any month in which Reseller fails to equal or exceed the Single Source Solutions Minimum Port Usage per Active Sprint Wholesale Dedicated Port as stated herein, Reseller shall pay Sprint a surcharge on its Sprint Wholesale Dedicated Outbound usage equal to the difference between 1. the Reseller's actual Single Source Solutions Net Usage for Sprint Wholesale Dedicated Outbound service and (b) the Single Source Solutions Minimum Port Usage multiplied by the total number of Single Source Solutions Active Sprint Wholesale Dedicated Outbound Ports. This surcharge shall be calculated at each CTIS Product Hierarchy Level.

5. Single Source Solutions Service Charges

Reseller shall pay Sprint a service charge of \$25.00 for each Resale End User ANI or toll free number that Reseller submits for activation that requires Sprint to disconnect or transfer such ANI or toll free number from Sprint's database before placing it within Reseller's CTIS hierarchy. However, the service charge provided will be waived if such Resale End User ANIs, or toll free numbers, do not exceed 15% of the total ANIs, or toll free numbers, submitted by Reseller during the previous 90 days.

6. Tax Exemption Certificates

Single Source Solutions pricing and discounts invoiced under CTIS are contingent upon Reseller providing Sprint with certificates from appropriate taxing authorities exempting Reseller from taxes that would otherwise apply under this Schedule.

7. Single Source Solutions Payphone Surcharge

Single Source Solutions Payphone Surcharge Resellers shall pay Sprint a per call surcharge of \$0.55 for each compensable payphone call (including FONCARD calls, toll free switched and dedicated services calls, Prepaid Card services calls, and 10XXX-0 Plus Dial Around service calls) for which Sprint is responsible for payment to the payphone owner.

7. Per Line Charges

When Sprint is assessed a Presubscribed Interexchange Carrier Charge by a LEC, Sprint will charge a Sprint subscriber's Resale End User an undiscounted per line charge found at [Sprint Single Source Solutions Per Line Charges](#).

8. Miscellaneous Services

This liability shall be waived at any location which upgrades service to Sprint's VPN Premiere Service with an equivalent usage and term commitment (see Sprint's Schedule No. 11).

6. Seasonality Adjustment

The subscriber's gross monthly product usage may be averaged to satisfy the monthly NWTTP usage commitment and guarantee. During the term period, a subscriber will receive NWTTP discounts if usage for that particular month justifies a discount. Averaging will be performed at the end of the term period, and any discounts to which a subscriber becomes entitled by virtue of averaging will be reflected on its following bill, if any, or by way of credit to a final bill. Seasonal adjustments will be applied as follows:

The total gross product usage over the term period will be divided by the number of months in the same period. If this quotient is greater than the minimum NWTTP monthly commitment, then (1) for those months in which the subscriber's gross usage was greater than the NWTTP guarantee and the subscriber received a NWTTP discount which was less than the seasonally adjusted NWTTP discount as determined by averaging the subscriber's gross monthly usage over the term period, then gross usage for those months will be discounted the difference between the Seasonally Adjusted NWTTP and the NWTTP discount previously awarded; and (2) for those months in which the subscriber had been billed the NWTTP guarantee, the subscriber will be credited the difference between the NWTTP guarantee and actual gross product usage.
